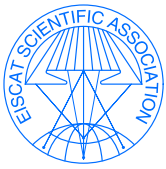

Dear all,

Please, find here the last information about the next week and the final program. Note that there are some adjusted times in the program. Note also the bus times.

- 1) Take your pass or valid ID card with you, since Longyerbyen is outside of Schengen area
- 2) On the first day afternoon, we only have coffee and baquette at UNIS. Since the dinner is scheduled at 20:00, it might be a good idea to have a good lunch before the flight from Tromsø.
- 3) Svalbard is known to have enjoyable mild autumn weather, on the average around 5-10 C. However, please be prepared for occasional cold/ rain/snow by having enough warm clothing with you accordingly, temperature might reach down to 0. We are still at midnight sun zone in Svalbard, so you might want to stay on deck of the boat at nights. Proper wind/rainproof jacket is recommended. A camera and small binoculars certainly would be a good idea.
- 4) The tour to the Glacier is easy walking, only a couple of kilometers. We will of course do it weather permitting. Standard hiking boots, as you would take for mountain trail hike in Norway, Sweden and Finland are recommended. Hornsund staff will have Polar Bear guards with rifles. There is a lot of time devoted for this activity, most of which will certainly be used by admiring the views and hearing about the facts concerning the glacier from our guides.
- 5) Unfortunately Toivo Iinatti had to cancel his participation. We have invited Juha Vierinen to come along instead. He will tell us about the status and coming actions with the new Kilpisjärvi KAIRA station.
